On August 17, 2007, this board stayed further proceedings in this appeal pending final resolution of *Columbia Gas Transmission v. Zaino* (July 28, 2006), BTA No. 2003-K-1876, a matter which has since been concluded. See *Columbia Gas Transm. Corp. v. Levin*, 117 Ohio St.3d 122, 2008-Ohio-511, certiorari denied (2009), 555 U.S. \_\_\_. Appellant now asks that the stay remain in effect pending resolution of two other appeals currently pending before this board as they involve related issues. See *Trunkline Gas Co. v. Wilkins*, BTA No. 2005-K-578, and *Panhandle Eastern Pipe Line Co. v. Wilkins*, BTA No. 2005-K-579. Upon consideration of the motion and the existing
