This matter is before the Board of Tax Appeals pursuant to a motion to compel discovery filed by the Board of Education for the South-Western City School District (“BOE”). The BOE asks this board to order the appellant, 7 Star Entertainment, Inc., to answer discovery requests, issued on December 1, 2008. Appellant has not responded to said motion.

On February 10, 2009, this board granted the BOE's motion to extend the discovery period until March 31, 2009.

Upon review of the motion, the memorandum in support attached thereto, and the record as a whole, this board finds that appellant has failed to respond to the discovery requests within the time prescribed by this board's Rules of Practice and Procedure, Ohio Adm. Code 5717-1-11(A)(3).

It is therefore ordered that 7 Star Entertainment, Inc., within fourteen (14) days of the issuance of this order, answer the discovery requests issued by the BOE.
