This matter is before the Board of Tax Appeals pursuant to a motion to compel discovery filed by appellant Bedford Board of Education (“BOE”). The BOE originally asks this board to order the appellee, Bedford Colony Club Apartments to

respond to discovery requests served on November 3, 2008.¹ Bedford Colony Club Apartments has not responded to said motion.

The BOE notes that it followed up with further requests that Bedford Colony Club Apartments respond to the discovery.

Upon review of the motion, the memorandum in support attached thereto, and the record as a whole, this board finds that Bedford Colony Club Apartments has failed to respond to the discovery requests within the time prescribed by this board's Rules of Practice and Procedure, Ohio Adm. Code 5717-1-11(A)(3).

It is therefore ordered that Bedford Colony Club Apartments shall, within fourteen (14) days of the issuance of this order, amend its answers to the discovery requests described above.
