This matter is before the Board of Tax Appeals pursuant to a motion to compel discovery filed by appellee/appellant Warrensville Heights Board of

Education (“BOE”). The BOE originally asks this board to order the appellant/appellee, ISF Associates, to respond to discovery requests served on February 4, 2009. ISF Associates has failed to provide any response to said motion.

The BOE notes that it followed up with further requests that ISF Associates respond to the discovery.

Upon review of the motion, the memorandum in support attached thereto, and the record as a whole, this board finds that ISF Associates has failed to respond to the discovery requests within the time prescribed by this board’s Rules of Practice and Procedure, Ohio Adm. Code 5717-1-11(A)(3).

It is therefore ordered that ISF Associates shall, within fourteen (14) days of the issuance of this order, amend its answers to the discovery requests described above.
