This matter is before the Board of Tax Appeals pursuant to a motion to compel discovery filed by the Board of Education for the Worthington City School District (“BOE”). The BOE asks this board to order the appellant, Shereen Hashmi, to answer discovery requests, issued on December 1, 2008. Mr. Hashmi has not responded to said motion.

On February 10, 2009, this board granted the BOE's motion to extend the discovery period until March 31, 2009. Further, this board ordered counsel for the appellant to seek permission to practice before this board, pursuant to Ohio Adm. Code 5717-1-02, to date this board has not received a response.

Upon review of the motion, the memorandum in support attached thereto, and the record as a whole, this board finds that Shereen Hashmi has failed to respond to the discovery requests within the time prescribed by this board's Rules of Practice and Procedure, Ohio Adm. Code 5717-1-11(A)(3).

It is therefore ordered that Mr. Hashmi, within fourteen (14) days of the issuance of this order, answer the discovery requests issued by the BOE.
