On February 26, 2009, the appellant board of education filed with this board a motion requesting an order compelling the appellee property owner, East End

Ro Burton, Inc., to respond to discovery previously served upon it by the appellant board of education. The appellee property owner has failed to respond or object to either the board of education's discovery requests or the present motion.

Upon consideration of the board of education's motion to compel and the documents attached thereto, the board finds said motion well taken and therefore the property owner is hereby ordered to provide information responsive to the board of education's discovery requests *within twenty one (21) days of the issuance of this order*. See, generally, Ohio Adm. Code 5717-1-11.

It is further the order of the board that *within twenty one (21) days of the issuance of this order* the Cuyahoga County Board of Revision prepare and file with this board the statutory transcript as required by Ohio Adm. Code 5717-1-09(B).
