By this Order reference is made to a certain letter filed with the Board of Tax Appeals on the 13th day of February, 1997, indicating that counsel for the parties have agreed that: (1) the merit hearing for these matters will commence on June 9, 1997; (2) the parties will exchange appraisal reports and identify witness who will give testimony at the hearing no later than May 5, 1997; and (3) the parties will make their respective expert and non-expert witnesses available for deposition during the three week period following the exchange of appraisal reports.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

(1) The merit hearing for this matter shall commence on Monday, June 9, 1997, at 9:00 A.M. at the offices of the Ohio Board of Tax Appeals, 24th floor, 20 East Broad Street, Columbus, Ohio 43215, and shall continue from day-to-day thereafter until complete;

(2) On or before May 5, 1997, each party shall deliver to the others their report(s) of expert witnesses;

(3) On or before May 5, 1997, each party shall deliver to the others a list of witnesses who will give testimony at the merit hearing;

(4) Each party shall make its expert and non-expert witnesses available for deposition during the three week period following the last day for exchange of reports of experts.
